What We've Practiced This Week


Reading: Reading time this week was packed with practicing the letter Nn (*eh-neh*)! We learned the syllables *na-ne-ni-no-nu*, identified words with the letter Nn, and determined if a word had the letter Nn at the beginning or the end. Besides this, we talked about characters from stories, summarized important story events, learned to read the word "no," and practiced our motions for each letter sound.

<u>Math</u>: This week started a new math unit that focuses on comparing size and ordering objects according to their size. We looked at real objects and different story scenes to learn how to compare objects using the words *grande*, *pequeño*, *alto*, and *bajo*.

Writing: This week we reviewed our school and classroom rules and then wrote about them! While we wrote, we practiced the sight words *yo*, *no*, *en*, *la* and *el*. We also worked on punctuation, capitalization, and leaving space between our words as we wrote our books.

Fall Theme: We had a great time learning about math this week as we talked about fall! We started the week by reading a book about different things that happen in fall. Then, we practiced comparing the size of different leaves and using the words *grande* and *pequeño*. Finally, we went on a leaf hunt, collected different colored leaves, and graphed what we had found!
