What We've Practiced This Week

Holiday Activities: We started our week by reading two books from the pigeon series by Mo Willems to prepare ourselves for a conversation about our needs and wants. We talked about our needs and wants and sorted different pictures into two groups to compare needs and wants. We also wrote two class books about different things that we need and things that we would like to have. Besides this, we also participated in other Christmas and holiday activities, like practicing sight words with reindeer and learning about the different ways lights are used during Christmas and the holidays.

<u>Writing</u>: We had a lot of fun this week with our Jan Brett author study. We read <u>El Mitón</u> (<u>The Mitten</u>) and <u>El Sombrero</u> (<u>The Hat</u>). After reading the books and discussing the beautiful illustrations, we wrote about the stories and then compared and contrasted the books. Look for more Jan Brett books at your local library!

Force and Motion: This week we became scientists and studied force, a push or a pull that makes an object move, and motion when an object changes position. We learned words like *fuerza* (force), *movimiento* (motion), *empujar* (push), and *jalar* (pull). We investigated strong and gentle pushes, what happens when a moving object hits a barrier, and what a floating object does when it is filled with extra weight. Be sure to ask your child what he or she liked best about science this week!
