## What We've Learned So Far

Reading: This week we've focused on learning Spanish vowels (las vocales)! Ask your child if they can remember each vowel's name and sound. Please be patient as your child learns the vowels, as they are easily confused with English vowels. Use your QR code reader and your child's Spanish Alphabet Book to listen to the Spanish vowels' names and sounds. Besides practicing the vowels, we also learned to read the word "yo" and practiced using it in sentence! We also learned about making good predictions while reading stories.

<u>Math</u>: This week we learned all about the numbers 1 and 2! We learned to write the numbers 1 and 2, find groups of 1 and 2, and draw pictures that show groups of 1 and 2. We also learned how to tell if two objects or groups are the same or different.

Writing: Ask your child to show you their name in the "kindergarten way," written with capital and lowercase letters!

<u>School Rules</u>: This week we focused on reviewing the school and classroom rules that we learned last week. See if your child can teach you our quiet signal with "the T" and if he or she can teach you some of our school rules!
