What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: We learned a new letter this week, the letter Mm (*eh-may*), and practiced reading the syllables “ma, me, mi, mo, and mu.” If you have access to the Internet at home, consider watching the alphabet videos on our classroom website with your child. The “Alphabet Rap” even includes the pronunciation of syllables with Mm!

Math: This week we continued counting groups with up to five objects. We talked about how the total number of objects doesn't change even when we rearrange the items in the groups. We also practiced identifying if two objects are the same or different. We've spent a lot of time learning how to describe similarities and differences that we see with “Math Talk” instead of simply saying whether the two things are the same or different!

Writing: We learned all about writing sentences this week! Each day, we wrote a new sentence to describe our feelings. As we wrote, we started our sentences with a capital letter, left spaces between our words, and included a period at the end.

Themes Focus on Colors: Our theme for this week was focused on learning the colors in Spanish. Not only did we dress in different colors each day, but we also wrote the color words, read short stories and poems about the different colors, played a color game, and practiced reading the color words,
