What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: This week we focused on the letter Ss (eh-say) and the syllables "sa, se, si, so, su." We practiced building, reading, and combining these syllables. We also practiced listening for the syllables in different words. While reading this week, we focused on identifying the characters in the stories we read. Besides this, we learned the words "el" and "la" and separated words into syllables. Take time to read to your child in English this weekend!

<u>Math</u>: On Monday, we wrapped up the first chapter of our math curriculum. We've gotten really good at counting up to five objects and telling when objects are the same and when they are different. Check out the "School to Home Connections" page in your child's Friday Folder for a more in depth look at what we will be learning over the next few weeks!

<u>Writing</u>: This week we learned to name our family members in Spanish. We practiced writing about our families using the new vocabulary. We focused on using one capital letter at the beginning of each sentence, leaving spaces between each word, and finishing our sentences with a period.

<u>Fire Safety:</u> We learned all about fire safety this week! We read several books about firefighters and discussed fire safety rules for at school and at home. We even had firefighters visit us on Friday! Be sure to check your child's Friday Folder for a "Home Fire-Safety Checklist."
