Reading: We learned the letter Pp this week and practiced the syllables "pa, pe, pi, po, pu." We also spent time reviewing our sight words, (yo, tú, estoy, el, la, and bien). While reading, we talked about rhyming words and practiced identifying the characters in a story. Take time to read to your child in English this weekend!

Next Week Reading:

The letter Tt (*tay*). Beginning sounds in words. Rhyming words. Making predictions.

Math:

Counting up to nine objects in a set. Writing the numbers 1-9. Matching equal groups.

Writing:

Writing with number words and sight words.

Social Studies and Science:

Living Things.

<u>Math</u>: In math this week, we practiced counting up to seven objects in a set. We talked about how the last number we say when we count tells us how many we have in all. We also reviewed how changing the order of the objects doesn't change the total! We read a few number poems, played a fun matching game to tell if groups were equal or not, and practiced writing numbers.

<u>Writing</u>: This week we authored our own books! While writing about what we do with our families, we reviewed the parts that every good sentence needs. We started our sentences with a capital letter, continued the sentences with lowercase letters, left spaces between words, and ended with a period.

Owl Theme: We had a hoot during our owl theme time! We read a great informational book that taught us about owls, practiced patterns with owls, learned a funny poem about little owls that mooed like cows, and made a fun owl craft! Ask your child what he or she learned about owls this week.
