What We've Practiced This Week

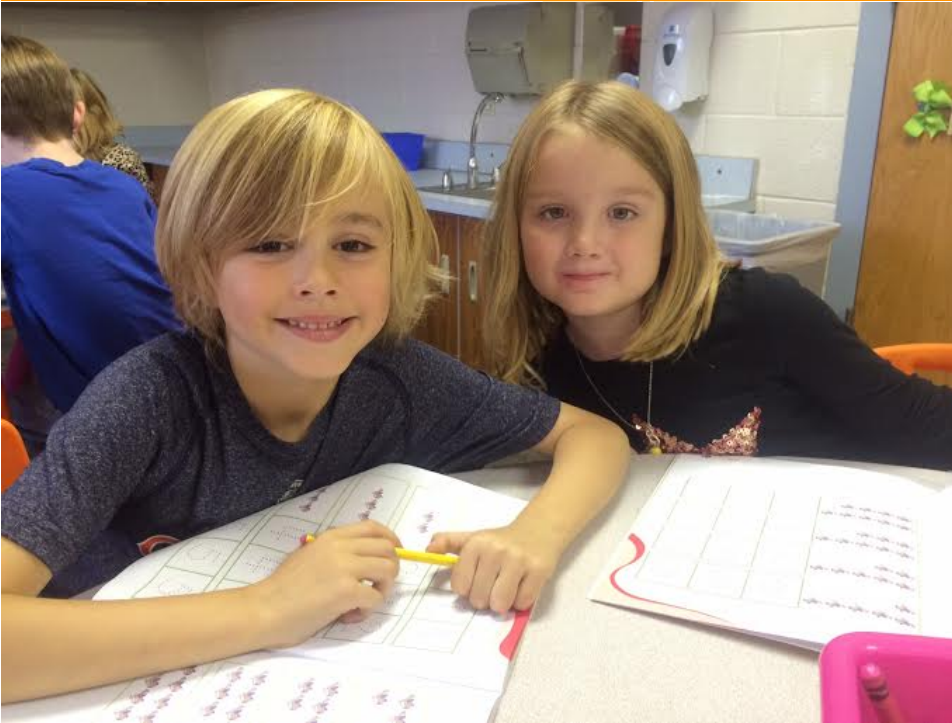
Reading: We were very busy this week during our reading time! We learned the letter Bb and practiced the syllables *ba-be-bi-bo-bu*. We practiced our handwriting with the letter Bb and we read words that are formed with syllables that have the letter Bb. We also practiced combining syllables to make words, reading the sight words *con* and *ella*, retelling the beginning, middle, and end of a story, and more. It was a productive week!

Math: This week during math time we continued to compare two groups of items and decide which had more and which had fewer items. We also practiced deciding if two groups of items were the same. Finally, we worked on pairing two different sets of objects, comparing their totals, and deciding what to do to make the sets equal so that each item matched with an item in the other group.

Writing: This week we were very excited to start a new book to write about the different things that we do with our moms. As we wrote, we remembered to start with a capital letter, use lowercase letters, leave spaces between words, and end with a period!

Pumpkin Theme: This week we enjoyed learning all about pumpkins. Not only did we learn about the parts of a pumpkin, but we also learned how a pumpkin grows, watched a video of a pumpkin growing, and read several pumpkin books. We also practiced location words in Spanish, e.g. above, next to, under, etc., using pumpkins!
