What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: Our focus letters this week were the letters Rr and RR/rr. We practiced writing the letters, reading syllables that begin with R & RR, and reading words with the syllables *ra-re-ri-ro-ru* and *rra-rre-rri-rro-rru*. Besides this letter work, we practiced the words *de* and *del* (of/from) and made sentences using these words. While reading different books about the weather, we also practiced talking about the setting of stories and finding details that help us understand what the author of a book is trying to say.

<u>Math</u>: We had a lot of fun this week as we compared objects' sizes. We started the week by reviewing the Spanish phrases for saying "bigger" and "smaller." Then, we talked about whether or not an object would fit into different-sized containers. We had a lot of opportunities to use "Math Talk" to explain our thoughts. Ask your child what we did with a shoe, a paperclip, and a crayon this week.

Writing: This week we again wrote about the weather. Each day, we wrote about the kinds of weather in which we like to play. We had fun illustrating all of the different types of weather!

Penguin Theme Focus: This week we began to learn about penguins! We started the week by reading about a "Not So Perfect" penguin named Percy. We also read informational texts about penguins, practiced naming the different parts of a penguin, and learned about the different things that penguins can do. Welcome Bock!
