WEEK EIGHTEEN

What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: This week we learned the letter Dd and syllables da-de-di-do-du. We listened to each syllable in different words, wrote the syllables, searched for words with the letter Dd, and practiced our handwriting with Dd. We also learned the words por (for/ through) and muy (very). While reading this week's stories, we retold the beginning, middle and end of the stories, described the settings, and looked for details in the illustrations and the text.

<u>Math</u>: During math time this week, we focused on "math talk" and using math language to describe the location of items and also to describe when an event occurred. We practiced using words and phrases like *antes*, *después*, *encima de*, *debajo de*, *al lado de*, *entre*, *dentro de*, *fuera de*, *enfrente de*, and *detrás de*.

<u>Writing</u>: This week we wrote about the toys with which we most enjoy playing. We practiced writing complete sentences with a capital letter at the beginning and a period at the end. We also began to practice adding details to our writing to make our writing more interesting for our readers!

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day: This week we took time to talk about the life and work of Dr. King. Our kindergarteners did a great job engaging in dialogue about respecting others and treating each other fairly.
