WEEK NINETEEN

What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: This week we learned and practiced the letter Ch/ch. We found words containing Ch, determined if Ch was at the beginning or end of a word, read the syllables *cha-che-chi-cho-chu*, and read words with Ch. While listening to stories this week, we discussed the setting of the stories and worked on retelling what happened in the stories. We also learned to read the words *soy* and *quién*!

<u>Math</u>: We began to learn about the base ten system this week. We began by discovering that we can't use our fingers to show numbers greater than 10. This activity taught us that teen numbers are made with a group of ten plus additional ones. We demonstrated this with the numbers 10-12, (e.g. 11 is a group of 10 and 1 more).

<u>Writing</u>: We practiced writing instructions this week during writing time. We wrote books about the steps that need to be followed in order to get ready to play outside in winter. We spent time planning the order of the instructions and we were sure to add detailed illustrations to help the reader understand!

<u>Wintertime</u>: This week we talked about winter. We started the week by learning about China's Frozen City, which is constructed with ice. We were amazed by the fact that you can walk into the buildings and spend time in the city! We also talked about polar bears and other Artic and Antarctic animals.
