## What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: This week we moved back to practicing a letter with five syllables, the letter Yy and the syllables ya-ye-yi-yo-yu. We practiced reading these syllables, writing words with the syllables, and deciding if words contained these syllables or not. Besides this, we reviewed our sight words from the past several weeks. While reading, we discussed stories' characters and practiced identifying the main ideas of the stories.
Math: During math this week, we practiced comparing sets of objects and figuring out how many more or less items a set had when compared to another set. We also practiced counting on from any given number, which will be a very important addition strategy as we continue on in math!
Writing: We worked hard this week to wrap up our writing projects on different jobs and professions! Each group finished writing their book, edited their writing with the teacher, and published the book using a computer with the teacher's help. Finally, the groups worked on illustrating their books. We look forward to being able to share our finished books with the whole class next week!

All Kinds of Patterns: This week we learned about patterns!
First, we discussed calendar patterns and how the days and months repeat. We also explored how many days are in each month! Then, we learned about making shape patterns.
