What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: This week we practiced the syllables ge and gi, which make the soft "Gg" sound, similar to the English "Hh." We practiced reading Gg syllables, ga-ge-gi-go-gu, and identifying what sound the Gg makes in each syllable. We found words with the syllables ge and gi and built words using these syllables. Besides this, we practiced reading the words las (the) and da (he/she gives ge you give). While reading this week, we practiced finding details in the stories' words and pictures to help us better understand the stories.

<u>Math</u>: During math this week, we continued to practice joining two numbers (or two sets of objects) to make a bigger number. To add to the challenge, we then asked the question, "How many more would we need to have 10 (or another number) in all?" We practiced using our fingers, a number line, and drawing pictures to figure out how many more would be needed to arrive at the larger number.

Writing: This week we continued learning about friendly letters. We first talked about being sure to write a letter for each sound we hear in a syllable so that the recipient can read what we write. We then spent the whole week carefully writing letters to each other!

Earth Day: This week we learned about Earth Day and how to help keep the earth clean and safe. We talked about picking up trash, recycling, and planting new trees. We also talked about plants and animals and even planted grass seeds!
