WEEK THIRTY-ONE

What We've Practiced This Week

Reading: We spent a lot of our reading time this week practicing the letter Gg. Last week we learned that Gg makes a soft sound in the syllables ge and gi, just like the Spanish letter Jj. This week, we learned that Gg makes the hard Gg sound, like in the English word go, when it's in the syllables gue and gui. The trick is that the Uu is silent in these syllables! Besides our syllable practice, we learned the words esto (this) and tiene (he/she has or you have). We also practiced finding important details in a story's words and pictures.

<u>Math</u>: During math time, we turned our focus to measurement. We reviewed the words *largo-corto* (long-short) and *alto-bajo* (tall/short). We then practiced comparing the length and height of different objects. Finally, we learned to use nonstandard units, like cubes and strings, to measure length and height. At the end of the week, we returned to addition, which we will focus on next week.

Writing: This week we learned how to write a different type of letter. We practiced writing invitations! We were sure to include information about our imaginary "events," including the time and the place. Ask your child what kinds of invitations he or she wrote!

<u>Insects</u>: This week we learned that all insects have three main body segments—a head, a thorax, and an abdomen. They also have two antenna and six legs! We practiced naming insects in Spanish and identifying creatures that are NOT insects.
