## Next Week

## What We've Practiced This Week

**Reading:** This week was packed full of practicing new letters and testing our reading knowledge! Not only did we practice the letters Zz and Kk and all of the syllables that can be formed with those letters, but we also reviewed this year's sight words, practiced blending syllables to form words, and talked about the difference between fantasy and reality in stories. To top it all off, we also started report card and reading testing to show what we have learned about letter names, letter sounds, reading syllables, and more. It was a busy week!

**Math:** This week we learned about subtraction and how to write equations for subtraction stories. We practiced using the minus and equal signs correctly. We also practiced writing subtraction equations to compare the totals of two sets of objects.

**Writing:** This week we began to write personal narratives, which are stories about our own experiences. Students practiced including important details in their narratives, answering the questions, "Who? What? Where? When? How?" We learned that it's important to include these details so others can understand what happened!

**Insect Theme:** This week we reviewed the characteristics of insects, talked about where different bugs live, practiced naming insects in Spanish, and even invented imaginary insects! We also read a few stories about *Hombre Mosca* (Fly Guy). Maestra Douglas
