Rocks and minerals.

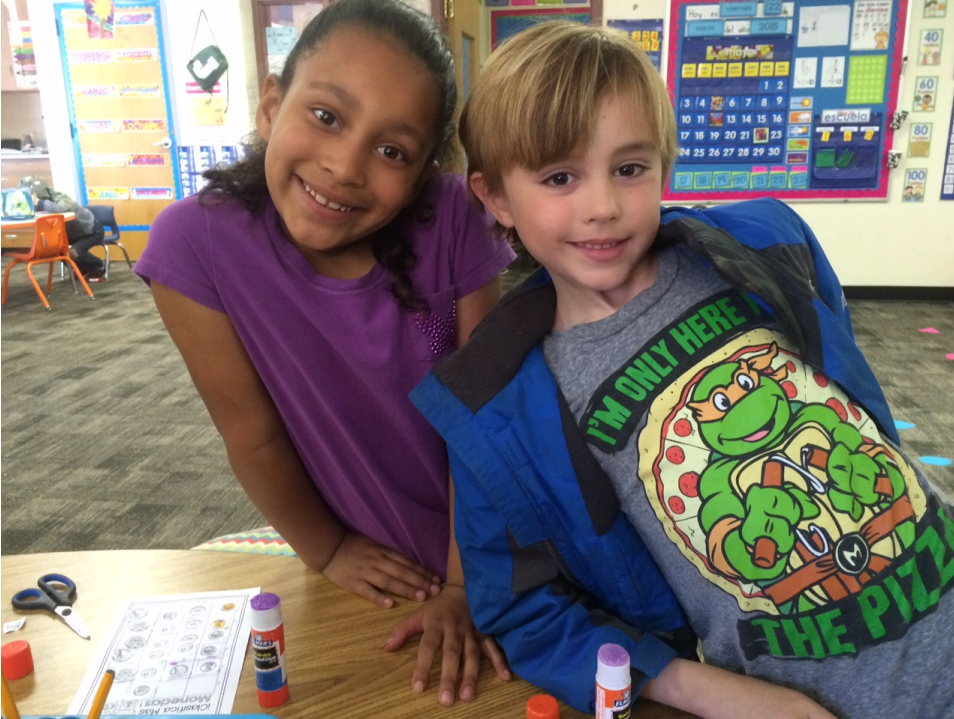
### What We've Practiced This Week

**Reading:** We were busy during reading time this week! Not only did we practice the letters Hh and Ww and the syllables *ha-he-hi-ho-hi* and *wa-we-wi-wo-wu*, but we also reviewed our sight words, read several stories with our sight words, and practiced separating words into syllables. We also continued report card testing and completed our end-of-year reading testing, which went very well!

**Math:** This week we learned about measurement. We started by learning about weight and how to use a balance to tell which of two items weighed more and less. We also found some items that weighed the same! Then, we learned about capacity and how to fill containers with different items to find out in which container more and fewer items fit. Finally, we learned about time and practiced identifying which of two activities took more and less time.

**Writing:** This week we continued working on our personal narratives and learned how to edit our work. Students read their stories to two different partners, who helped revise the writing by suggesting new ideas and identifying errors in the stories. We then rewrote our stories, just like real authors do!

**Rocks and Minerals:** This week we began to learn about rocks. We went on a rock hunt and practiced describing the characteristics of the rocks we found. We also learned about the “rock cycle,” how big rocks can change to pebbles and even sand. Maestra Douglas
